



Assistance Program Guidelines and Request

FAITH "Fighting Cancer" is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes. We are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, run by a team of compassionate volunteers and are not faith based. Our mission is to provide emotional and financial support to cancer patients and their families as well as assist in educational and preventative care programs in Montgomery County, Texas. We accomplish our mission with the generous donations of businesses, individuals, other local 501(c)(3) charities and an active group of dedicated volunteers.

Due to overwhelming requests, eligible applicants are limited to one time assistance.

You must meet the following qualifications to request an application:

- The patient is currently and has lived in Montgomery County, TX for the past 12 months
- The patient is currently receiving cancer treatment
- The patient has not received prior assistance from this program
- The patient or legal guardian must sign and submit the final application

All requests for applications are reviewed and the extent if any assistance is a board decision. You will be contacted within 30 days by email or US Mail with a full application or a non-qualifying notice.
